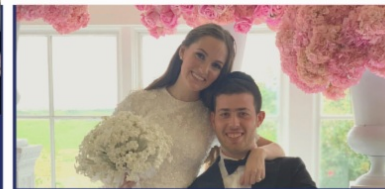

She has served as Education Director at The Jewish Center on Manhattan's Upper West Side and lectures in communities in the United States and Israel. A Midreshet Lindenbaum alumna, she holds a BA from Stern College, an MA in Medieval Jewish History from Yeshiva University, and completed the Drisha Institute Scholars Circle Program. She lives in Neve Daniel with her husband and their children.
